Policy Statement

On Shipments and Transportation of Agrichemicals from an AWSA Certified SITE

Agrichemicals must only be shipped from an AWSA Certified sites into either another AWSA Certified site or directly to an end user location.

Trucks cannot be used for warehousing or temporary storage. Direct long-haul shipments are considered in transit.

The Standards do not place any restrictions on the sale of product. Product may be sold to and/or by individuals or companies that do not have a Certified warehouse, provided that the product is shipped directly from a Certified warehouse to the end user location. In all cases, documentation must be prepared by the Certified warehouse, consigning each individual drop-off shipment to each end user (grower) location.

Applicable Federal and Provincial regulations (e.g., Transportation of Dangerous Goods/Provincial Vendor's licensing requirements/grower certification number) must be adhered to at all times.

Seed Treatment Products

Seed Treatment Products must be shipped in accordance with the Accredited Seed Treatment Operations Standards. Seed Treatment Products can only be shipped to:

- Another Certified AWSA Warehouse;
- An Accredited Seed Treatment Operator;
- A Grower provided that a waiver has been signed.

Greenhouse labelled PCP Registered Crop Protection Products

Prior to shipping greenhouse labelled PCP products retailers must record the Protected Ag certification number of the receiving grower or have on file a Protected Ag waiver for the grower. Note both of these are location specific (for each greenhouse site).
